

# STORM DAMAGE CHECKLIST

In the aftermath of the great July 1, 2011, thunderstorm, here are some not-so-obvious plumbing-related storm damage items to check for at your home or cabin:

- ❧ Broken or plugged plumbing vent on roof.
- ❧ Broken or damaged gas regulator or gas piping on side of house or on LP Gas tank.
- ❧ Damaged exhaust vents on roof or side of house.
- ❧ Damaged underground gas, sewer or water piping caused by disturbed tree roots or by falling branches puncturing the ground.
- ❧ Damaged vent or clean-out pipes serving your septic system.
- ❧ Damaged wiring serving your water pump, effluent pump, or effluent alarm.
- ❧ Damaged well casing or pump house.
